With spring in the air and warmer weather approaching our residents and children will be out and about, please remember:

Your trash and recycle totes **cannot be left** on the sidewalk after pick-up by Eagle. Store them in a neat fashion to the side or rear of your home.



**CONTROL & MAINTENANCE OF ANIMALS DOG BARKING** (Ordinance 185) – Pet owners are reminded to control/monitor your pet from barking excessively so as not to be a disturbance to others. Also, pets must be controlled on a leash at all times and owners must clean up after their pets. Outdoor cats (Ordinance 236) need to be spayed, tipped and immunized. Non-compliance has a fine of \$15.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> two offenses and as high as \$1,000 for subsequent violations.



**Burning-Portable Outdoor Fireplaces**-A portable fireplace shall be no more than three feet in diameter but not limited to chimineas, patio units, heating lamps and cast iron fire pits. A portable fireplace shall at all times be operated a minimum of 15 feet from any structure or combustible material i.e.; under trees and the flame height is to be limited to 3 feet. Fires shall be attended by an adult at all times. All fires are to be extinguished no later than 12:00 midnight on Friday and Saturday and no later than 10:00 pm Sunday through Thursday. Absolutely no burning of paper and/or rubbish.  
**Recreational foods only.**
