**Trash/recycle bins:**

We have been receiving an increase in complaints regarding trash bins being left out on the sidewalks past Monday evening. Please remember that trash bins need to be removed from the sidewalk promptly after trash service pick up.

Let's keep our sidewalks clean, safe and our neighbor's happy by practicing responsible dog ownership:

- All dogs must be on a leash.
- Please carry plastic bags with you to pick up after them. When disposing please do so in your own trash.
- Monitor and control excessive barking inside and outside your home to avoid them becoming a disturbance to others.

Maintaining our Properties:

- Keep curbs and sidewalks free of weeds.
- Keep grass less than six inches in height.
- Keep grass clippings out of the street.
- Keep bushes and trees trimmed
- Keep front porches and sidewalks clear of clutter.
- Pick up trash that blows in the streets

Burning-Portable Outdoor Fireplaces A portable fireplace shall be no more than three feet in diameter but not limited to chimineas, patio units, heating lamps and cast iron fire pits. A portable fireplace shall at all times be operated a minimum of 15 feet from any structure or combustible material i.e.; under trees and the flame height is to be limited to 3 feet. Fires shall be attended by an adult at all times. All fires are to be extinguished no later than 12:00 midnight on Friday and Saturday and no later than 10:00 pm Sunday through Thursday. **Absolutely NO** burning of paper and/or rubbish.

Keeping information up to date:

If you change a phone number or eliminate a home line, please remember to contact the borough with a new contact number. In case of an emergency we will contact you via swift reach call. You may also write the new information on you W/S/T bill and we will make the change.

Council Meetings are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month @ 7 pm. Extra meetings are the last Wednesday of every month @7 pm. All residents are invited to attend.

White Goods (Large Appliances) and Tire Collection (no rims):

April 17th

Leaf Collection Dates:

April 10th

*Yard waste bags for yard waste and leaf collection can be picked up at the Christiana Borough Office during normal business hours. Cost is \$0.50ea or 12 for \$5.00
